

Reading Miles Global Challenge

It's not that easy to travel at the moment but we are thinking about people all over the world. Why not read your way around the world with the Reading Miles Global Challenge.

Every Wednesday, Abbey Hulton Primary have a reading assembly where we share book reviews and recommendations and children get presented with a certificate when they have reached a check point (they also have 5 mins extra play too!)

Collect 500 reading miles for every 10 minutes you spend reading, either alone or with a parent, carer, or your brother or sister. You could even video call your relatives and read aloud to them. Collect reading miles in a special reading passport on your very own reading world tour - a whopping 33,000 miles (or 11 hours) in total!

The challenge is split into seven journeys, each of which finishes in a 'checkpoint city'.

The following resources are used in school:

- A wall map of the world charting the Reading Miles Global Challenge route
- A passport to record the reading
- A certificate for when you reach a check point

When you have made it around the world, you will receive a golden ticket and your name goes into a raffle for a big prize at the end of the year...like a kindle or theatre tickets!!!
